UNIVERSITY OF ZARAGOZA, SPAIN

The Courses in Spanish as a Foreign Language are run throughout the year in Zaragoza, Huesca and Teruel, while in the summer they are transferred in the tourist city of Jaca in the Pyrenees.

The University of Zaragoza is a pioneer in teaching Spanish to foreign students since 1927. It collaborates with many national and international institutions in the dissemination of the Spanish language. It is an Oficial Examination Center for the Diploma of Spanish DELE, The International Spanish Language Evaluation Service (acronym in Spanish: SIELE) and the Test of Constitutional and Sociocultural Knowledge of Spain (CCSE), by delegation of Instituto Cervantes. In addition, it is an associated member of International Certification System for Spanish as a Foreign Language (SICELE). The examination in order to obtain the spanish nationality (DELE A2 and CCSE) take place in Zaragoza, Huesca and Teruel.

The University of Zaragoza is recognized worldwide, as demonstrated by the large number of foreign students attending as part of the various programmes that promotes and cooperates. The ELE Courses participate in these programmes, and also organize specific courses for foreign universities at their request.



COURSES IN SPANISH AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE IN ZARAGOZA

The city of Zaragoza has a population of more than 700,000 inhabitants. It is the capital of Aragon. It offers visitors the testimony of its more than two thousand years of history, with traces of its Roman, Arab, Jewish and Christian heritage.

Its privileged geographical location among Madrid, Barcelona, Bilbao and Valencia make it a natural meeting point for many activities of all kinds: conferences, national and international exhibitions, sporting events, artistic and scientific meetings, festivals, fairs, concerts, etc.

SPANISH LANGUAGE AND CULTURE COURSES FOR FOREIGN STUDENTS

DELE EXAM PREPARATION INTENSIVE COURSES

DELE is an internationally recognized official certificate of the Instituto Cervantes and offered by Spanish Courses of the University of Zaragoza (https://examenes.cervantes).

Three successive courses are offered that will take place in prior to the fortnights the official DELE exam dates (November, April and July).

42 class hours

Registration fee for the course: €250. Students of Year Course will have a 50% discount of the total price €125.

The aim of these Courses is to prepare students for the exams leading to the DELF.

SIELE EXAM SPECIFIC PREPARATION INTENSIVE COURSES

SIELE is an internationally recognized official certificate offered by Spanish Courses of the University of Zaragoza as an exam center: (https://siele.org/).

They are taught in 57 hours of theory classes (a total of 75 hours including the SIELE exam).

SEMI-PRESENTIAL INTENSIVES COURSES AND TUTORIZED COURSES ONLINE

These Courses are based on the online AVE Global del Instituto Cervantes (ave.cervantes.es), adjusted to the CEFR. Two types of courses are offered:

A) SEMI-PRESENTIAL INTENSIVE COURSE

Course content (4 weeks):

- 60 hours of online materials (A1, A2, B1, B2 o C1).
- 4 class hours organized in small groups (in the afternoon).
- Personalized monitoring of the activities via e-mail or chats during all the course (settlement of any doubts, correction of student's tasks, etc.).

Limited places available.

Course price: €210.

This price includes all the online activities and the in-person classes as well as the achievement certificate (for those students who will have realized at least the 85% of the activities and pass the tests).

Courses dates: coincide with the dates of the Intensive Courses (page 6).

B) WEB-MENTORED COURSE

Course content (4 weeks):

- 60 hours of online materials (A1, A2, B1, B2 o C1).
- 4 class hours organized in small groups (1 hour per week).
- Personalized monitoring of the activities via e-mail or chats during the course (settlement of any doubts, correction of student's tasks, etc.).

INITIAL TEACHER TRAINING COURSE FOR TEACHERS OF SPANISH AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE

21th EDITION OF THE COURSE

Zaragoza, 7 February - 27 March 2020.

Run in collaboration with the Instituto Cervantes and the Aragon Regional Government.

50 class hours.

Registration fee for the course: €385.

Classes about problematic areas of the spanish grammar as a foreign language (ELE), as well as its methodologies.

The course will be taught on Friday afternoons and Saturday mornings.

Target students: Spanish and foreign teachers of Spanish as a foreign language, Philology (preferably Spanish) graduates or final year students who wish to focus their training on teaching Spanish to foreign students. Given the initial nature of this course, enrolment is not recommended for people who have already attended similar courses.

Students who consistently attend and make full use of the classes will be awarded an approved diploma which can be validated by the Department of Education, Culture and Sports of the Government of Aragon, carrying 5 credits for Permanent Teacher Training qualifications, provided that the students fulfil the requirements established by the relevant official bodies.

The course may be validated with 1,5 Credits ECTS by the University of Zaragoza.

The number of available places is limited. Applicants must NOT make any payments before receiving confirmation of their admission on the course.

SUMMER COURSES IN SPANISH AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE IN JACA

The Summer Courses in Spanish as a Foreign Language run by the University of Zaragoza in Jaca are the oldest in Spain, having been founded in 1927.

The city of Jaca, some 820 metres above sea level, was the capital of the old kingdom of Aragon and is today a leading tourist resort in the heart of the Aragonese Pyrenees, offering a wide range of cultural events and services, including concerts, street markets, exhibitions, lectures and conferences.

Its natural setting and facilities are ideal for many sports, including paragliding, horse riding, ice skating, rambling, etc.

The city has always been and continues to be a favoured way stage for pilgrims on the St. James Way and a focus for exchange and understanding between cultures. It also constitutes a gateway to Europe as it is only a few kilometres from the French border.

Together with the Spanish Courses for Foreign Students, Spanish Teacher Training Courses are also offered. Spanish-speaking students participate in these courses allowing Spanish and Foreign students the opportunity to spend time together and practise their language skills.
